CALL TO ORDER

Marybeth Orton, Board Chair called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

MINUTES

FINANCIAL REPORTS

The financial statements for the months ending April 30, 2015 and May 31, 2015 were presented to the Board for review. No further action was required.

REPORT FROM O&P

The Board reviewed the June 2015 report for the Office of Occupations and Professions from Gordon Slone, Executive Director. No further action was required.

LICENSURE STATUS REPORT

A Licensure Status Report dated June 16, 2015 was presented to the Board for review. The report showed there are currently 83 active licensed Professional Art Therapists and 29 active licensed Professional Art Therapists Associates. No further action was required.

NEW BUSINESS

The board discussed the Cabinet for Health and Family Services meeting in which Stewart Bridgman, Gordon Slone, and Ms. Orton attended on May 22, 2015. The meeting reviewed the role of licensure data in evaluating health care workforce capacity and needs. The board decided to table the discussion. No further action was required.

After review and discussion the board agreed to add web links to some of the language in the chart. The board agreed to table posting the flow chart on the website until it was finalized. No further action was required.
