

**KENTUCKY BOARD OF LICENSURE FOR PROFESSIONAL ART THERAPISTS

CALL TO ORDER

Marybeth Orton, Acting Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:28 p.m.

APPOINTMENT OF NEW BOARD MEMBERS

Marian K. Lancaster was appointed as a new member of the Kentucky Board of Licensure for Professional Art Therapists by Steven L. Beshear, Governor. Ms. Lancaster was sworn in by Robin Vick of the Office of Occupations and Professions.

MINUTES

A motion was made by Ms. Lancaster to approve the minutes of the January 23, 2013 meeting as amended. Motion, seconded by John Sykes, carried.

FINANCIAL REPORTS

The financial statements for the months ending January, February, and March 2013 were presented to the Board for review. A motion was made by Mr. Sykes to approve the financial reports. Motion, seconded by Ms. Lancaster, carried.

LICENSURE STATUS REPORT

A Licensure Status Report dated April 16, 2013 was presented to the Board for review. The report showed there are currently 82 active licensed Professional Art Therapists. No further action was required.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board discussed at length the Licensed Professional Art Therapists Associate (LPATA) level licensure process. Jim Grawe, Board Attorney presented the Board with a copy of the new statute and changes. Mr. Grawe also presented the Board with a handout on supervision requirements from four (4) different boards for review and discussion. The Board agreed to review the handout and report back what they liked and didn't like and to hold a special meeting to begin drafting the regulations for the LPATA.

The Board scheduled a special meeting for May 1, 2013 work on KAR changes related to Licensed Professional Art Therapists Associate level license.

The Board briefly discussed asking KYATA to pursue the legislative agenda for Medicaid reimbursement for LPAT's. A motion was made by Mr. Sykes to have Ms. Lancaster contact KYATA regarding the matter. Motion, seconded by Ms. Lancaster, carried.

The Board tabled discussion on adding three (3) hours of ethics training for CEU requirements for licensure renewal until the special meeting. No further action was taken.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS

The Board reviewed two (2) applications for Emily Rae Johnson and Angela M. Pleasant. A motion was made by Ms. Lancaster to approve Emily Rae Johnson's application for licensure and Angela M. Pleasant's application to sit for the upcoming ATCB examination in June. Motion, seconded by Mr. Sykes, carried.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

A motion was made by Ms. Lancaster to approve the continuing education applications as presented. Motion seconded by Mr. Sykes, carried. The following courses were approved:
