CALL TO ORDER

Virginia Lee Alcott, Board Chair called the meeting to order at 1:34 p.m.

MINUTES

A motion was made by Stewart G. Bridgman, Jr. to approve the minutes of the August 1, 2012 meeting. Motion, seconded by John Sykes, carried.

FINANCIAL REPORTS

The financial statements for the months ending August and September were presented to the Board for review. A motion was made by Mr. Bridgman to approve the financial reports. Motion, seconded by Marybeth Orton, carried.

The fiscal department provided Mr. Bridgman with the last six (6) years of financial statements for review. No further action was required.

O&P REPORT

Lucie Duvall, Board Administrator reported to the Board on issues at O&P. Ms. Duvall introduced Wendy Tucker, Resource Management Analyst, I to the Board and informed them she would be handling any updates or changes to the website. No further action was required.

LICENSURE STATUS REPORT

A Licensure Status Report dated October 23, 2012 was presented to the Board for review. The report showed there are currently 82 active licensed Professional Art Therapists. The report also indicated there had been one (1) license issued from August 1, 2012 to October 23, 2012. No further action was required.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board reviewed updates to the website from the last meeting. The Board requested Stewart G. Bridgman, Jr.'s credentials be added to the end of his name. The Board also requested the exam date for the ATCB of June 29, 2013 in Louisville be listed on the website as well as a

quick link for the Board meeting dates. Wendy Tucker is to update the website with said changes. No further action was required.

The Board briefly reviewed the Code of Professional Practice of the Art Therapy Credentials Board, Inc. (ATCB). The Board tabled the matter for a later date.

The Board reviewed correspondence from the Art Therapy Credentials Board, Inc. (ATCB) regarding the posting of the Kentucky exam date to their website. The ATCB Board of Directors' Annual Meeting was said to meet on October 27-28 where the matter would be reviewed. Rita Maloy, MPA, with ATCB said she would follow up with Board regarding their decision.

The Board reviewed the application instructions for the LPAT application. A motion was made by Ms. Orton to withdraw the application instructions from the website and hard copy. Motion, seconded by Mr. Bridgman, carried.

The Board scheduled their 2013 meetings for January 16, April 17, July 17 and October 16. No further action was required.
